## You are already Reconciled to God so you can have healing and prosperity

We show you several scriptures showing that you are already reconciled to God, whether you know it or not. You must, however, know that you are indeed reconciled to God or you will never have confidence that you can receive wealth or healing or even salvation.

Once you fully understand that you are already reconciled to God, whether you know it or not, your faith will rise in you to a level you've never known before.

The Abraham covenant contains healing, prosperity, family well being and salvation. The Jews had these four things by birth in the Abrahamic covenant. They maintained them by making the proper sacrifice according to Moses' law when they sinned.

In the New Testament era, they maintain these blessings by accepting God's final sacrifice for sin under Moses' law. This final sacrifice is Jesus. God no longer accepts the blood of bulls and goats, just the blood of

Jesus. Consequently, when a Jew sins now who has accepted Jesus as God's final sacrifice, he maintains the same healing, prosperity, family well being and salvation he was born with. He maintains these blessings because Jesus sacrifice is everlasting and does not have to be repeated since he lives forever.

Gentiles who accept Jesus as his/her savior and Lord, are grafted into the same group above. Therefore, we Gentile Christians are partakers of the same healing, prosperity, family well being and salvation the physical seed of Abraham had beginning in Genesis 12.

Nevertheless, we are insecure about our ability to receive healing and prosperity in particular. We feel we have been too bad to deserve these blessings.

*The purpose of this article is to prove to you that Jesus has already reconciled you to God and you do not have one thing to worry about.*

## Reconciliation Scriptures proving you can have healing and prosperity!

Heb 2:14-18

14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

15 And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

16 For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham.

17 Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

## Act on these Scriptures for healing and prosperity

18 For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted. (KJV)

In other words, Jesus became everything necessary to reconcile us to God. He became flesh and blood. He took on the seed of Abraham. He did not take the nature of angels. He was made like his flesh and blood brethren. He suffered being tempted. He was totally equipped *to make reconciliation to God for the sins of the people.*

Praise God! *Jesus made reconciliation to God for the sins of us all.* We are not required to do it ourselves.

Rom 5:6  
6 For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. (KJV)

This verse says it very simply but powerfully. Our reconciliation was brought about by Jesus' death. Most importantly, notice that it was for the ungodly that he died. We are not required to be perfect for the death of Christ to work in our behalf. Furthermore, notice the state we were in when Christ died for us: when we were too weak to help ourselves. Oh

the matchless grace of God. We were ungodly. We were too weak to help ourselves, yet he did it for us anyway. Our reconciliation is complete from the cross forward.

Rom 5:8  
8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (KJV)

Two things here: we were still sinners when he loved us enough to die for us. Again, we were not required to become perfect before he loved us enough to die for us. We were still sinners when it happened. Our reconciliation is complete from the cross forward.

Col 1:21  
21 And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled. (KJV)

This Scripture is absolutely startling. It says that he has now reconciled us. In Greek, this means Jesus reconciled us in one solitary act. Our reconciliation is complete from the cross forward.

But this is not all. Look at the word *enemies*. This word, in Greek, means hatred. In other words, when Christ

died to bring about our reconciliation, we humans were *God-haters!* God Haters! Yet he died to complete and present us the gift of reconciliation. Again notice: He reconciled us. We did not reconcile ourselves. He made our reconciliation and gave it to us.

2 Cor 5:18

18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; (KJV)

Notice here that God reconciled us to himself but he did it through Jesus. Our reconciliation that he made is complete from the cross forward.

Rom 5:10

10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life. (KJV)

Here we see that our reconciliation is complete through the death of Jesus. Again, we are not required to be perfect as he died for us when we were not perfect.

Eph 2:13

13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ. (KJV)

Now we see that we are taken out of the *far off group* and placed in the *near group*. This transfer was powered by the blood of Christ. This transfer by his blood completed our reconciliation. We were not required to be perfect and belong to the right *in crowd*. All that was required was the blood of Jesus!

Rom 5:1

1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: (KJV)

All the above secures peace with God for us through our Lord Jesus Christ. Again, we are not required to be perfect. Jesus was perfect so we don't have to be.

Rom 5:2

2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. (KJV)

Here it is plain. We have access into this grace which includes our completed reconciliation from the cross forward.

Eph 2:14

14 For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us; (KJV)

The middle wall of partition above is the law of Moses. Jesus is the one who broke it down. Actually, Jesus did six things to Moses' law. (There are more than six things he did to it but these six will get you started.)

Here they are. Jesus broke it down, he abolished it, he slew it, he took it out of the way, he nailed it to his cross and he blotted it out. This was necessary for him to make a reconciliation complete from the cross forward.

Understand the above and healing and prosperity are within your grasp. Without understanding and believing the above, we will forever carry a guilt complex. We will feel that God would never give me healing or prosperity because I am too bad. I'm just not worthy enough. God would never bless me with healing and prosperity.

Your feeling of unworthiness is a lie. You are worthy because Jesus made you a complete reconciliation at the cross. It still stands today.
